POLICY ON ACCEPTANCE OF PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED DOCUMENTS AND PASSING EXAM SCORES UPON RE-APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE

This policy applies to individuals who re-apply for licensure.

Only the following documentation will be accepted from an applicant's previous application/professional file:

A. Official transcripts;

B. The applicant's score on the Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology

(EPPP) or the National School Psychology Examination;

C. Documentation of Experience forms;

D. Jurisprudence examination passing score, provided that not more than four years have elapsed since the passage of the exam, unless the applicant holds active

licensure with this Board at the time the application is received;

E. Oral examination passing score.

All other documentation required by the Board must be resubmitted, regardless of whether the person's original file contains copies of the required documentation.

Additionally, an individual who was formerly an LSSP with the Board and who retired in good standing and who has had no disciplinary action would not be required to be supervised for one year after re-licensure as an LSSP.
