REQUEST FOR RETIREMENT STATUS

461.7 (e) Retirement Status. A licensee who is on active or inactive status with the Board may retire by notifying the Board in writing prior to the renewal date for the license. A licensee seeking to retire after his or her renewal date must submit proof of compliance with the Board's professional development requirement. A licensee with a pending complaint, a restricted license, or who is otherwise not in compliance with all applicable Board rules may not retire his or her license. Permission to retire will not be granted for the purpose of allowing a licensee to avoid compliance with Board rule §461.11 of this title, unless the licensee presents to the Board evidence of extreme medical hardship and the Board grants the request. A licensee who retires shall be reported to have retired in good standing.
